Welcome to Bonn!

From federal capital to United Nations Campus – Bonn is remarkable for its cosmopolitan, Rhenish savoir-vivre with an international flair. 19 United Nations organisations make the city a major location for conventions and conferences – which is one of the reasons why sustainable economic management has become one of the city’s core concerns.

Protecting the environment and the climate as well as conserving resources are high priorities at Bonn Youth Hostel as well. As an official “Partner of Sustainable Bonn”, the hostel consistently implements sustainable economic management principles.

In addition to its commitment to the future, Bonn YH as a leisure and event destination is also worth a trip for families and groups. Almost 40 museums, 7 theatres, a programme of cultural events of the highest quality, its charm as a university city, its political past and of course the attractive scenery with the Siebengebirge hills, the Rheinauen park on the banks of the Rhine and the Drachenfels hill continue to attract visitors to Beethoven’s birth town.



Location. The hostel is located on the Venusberg – quiet, in a leafy suburb and yet close to the city, since the centre of Bonn 4 km from the hostel is easily reached by public transport. Getting to Cologne-Bonn Airport is just as easy on the airport bus from the city, taking only 30 minutes

Facilities. Light and spacious guest rooms, all fitted with shower and toilet, create a pleasant atmosphere. The modern bistro and the large patio are attractive meeting places for making interesting contacts. All facilities in the hostel are fully suitable for wheelchair users.

- A total of 81 rooms with 249 beds, all rooms with shower/toilet
- 9 single rooms
- 24 twin rooms
- 48 four-bed rooms
- 28 rooms (single and twin) are suitable for wheelchair users, 2 of these for electrical wheelchairs

Service. The hostel is open around the clock, and the hostel team is at your disposal every day from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m. As a competent and dedicated team, we do our best to answer all your queries and to help you with any wishes you may have. Conference participants in particular benefit from individual consulting service already during the planning stage of their conference.



Catering. Our kitchen team will be happy to cater for vegetarian and religious eating habits. We set great store by a balanced and modern diet, which includes serving only TransFair coffee, meat from animals bred under humane conditions, as well as certified organic whole-grain bakery products.

Leisure time activities. A large number of museums and sights bear witness to the city's great history. Leisure parks and interesting destinations nearby make attractive day trips. The former federal capital offers plenty of sights. Enough to have some left when you come back to Bonn for your next visit.

Leisure facilities. The modern bistro and the large patio are ideal meeting places for getting to know people or planning your next sightseeing tour.

Conferences and seminars. Working close to the city and yet in peace and quiet: Bonn YH offers ideal conditions for conferences and seminars. Nine conference rooms (ranging in size from 11 to 105 m²) can accommodate up to 120 people. With full conference equipment including Internet access, and the hostel's own high ropes course, the hostel's location close to the city is perfectly suited for both indoor and outdoor events. Low-priced conference packages and individual arrangements complete the service.



Sightseeing

History, politics, arts and sciences – the former federal capital of Bonn boasts a varied range of cultural activities:

A visit to a museum, a stroll through the city, the boat trip on the Rhine or the excursion to the Siebengebirge hills close by. There is something for everybody.

- Arts, history and science right next to each other: Mile of Museums (10 mins by car/30 mins by public transport)
- A great composer, great music: Beethoven House (15 mins by car /20 mins by public transport)
- A princely attraction: Poppelsdorf Chateau / Botanical Gardens (15 mins by car /20 mins by public transport)
- Legendary: Drachenfels hill (25 mins by car)
- Sharks and rays near the Rhine: Sealife Center in Königswinter (20 mins by car)
- A wealth of experience: “Phantasialand” leisure park (30 mins by car)



What makes us special. Sustainable economic management also goes with commitment to the future of children and young people. Our “Job fit“ programme prepares students in Year 8 and older for entering the world of work: Getting to know their own strengths, presenting themselves with confidence in job interviews as well as support in deciding on a career helps students to find out where they want to go. Other programmes supervised by education specialists offer a large variety of training courses for apprentices, designed to teach young people to develop social skills, work in a team and master their daily work situation as apprentices with confidence.
