## Young committed adults stand up for their future!

From the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2013 onward, committed young adults, between 18 and 28 years old, can register for the Youth Future Conference. The conference is going to take place in Bonn from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 7<sup>th</sup> of September. Invited are next to 100 young people from all over Europe as well as Laureates of the „Alternative Nobel Prize“ (the Right Livelihood Award) and the German Environmental Prize awarded by the German Environmental Foundation. The conference has its main focus on a holistic view at current environmental topics.

For the third time committed young people of the „Youth Future Project e.V.“ are organizing a conference, which this year will be about environment and sustainability. The conference will be attended by about 100 active young people from all over Europe, PhD Scholars of the German Environmental Foundation and the Right Livelihood College, as well as Laureates. Through networking and eye-on-eye interaction with inspiring role models the participants will come up with hands-on solutions.

The participants will take part in a workshop of a given topic, like „post growth society“, „renewable energies“ or „sustainable consumption“. Every day the workshop's topic will be viewed from a different point of view: economy, ecology, state/social, and culture. The workshops are framed by activities like lectures and “Open Space” sessions, which will give room for ideas and discussions.

The aim of the conference is the development of initiatives and projects by the participants. The projects will be developed out of new insights on the treated topics. The most promising of these initiated or further developed projects are going to be democratically elected. These projects will be then accepted to a small project support program which is going to support them with the realization and evolvment towards a societal effect.

Addressed are all young adults between 18 and 28 years, who care about a sustainable future, want to network and get to know inspiring personalities.
